

Subject: September 30th is the Deadline for Assigning Crop Priority in ACRE program

September 30th is the deadline for assigning crop priority for those farms choosing the ACRE program. The choice of priority only matters on farms where planted acres exceed total base acres times 1.2. On many Illinois farms, priority will not matter. On those where priority matters, current forecasts suggest that corn should be the number 1 priority, wheat the second (if it is grown), and soybeans the third. Priority choices on corn and wheat are close.
